2022 Trail Competition

All Cherokee County Saddle Club Members are invited to participate in this year's Trail Competition, running from January 1, 2022 –December 31, 2022.

This is a fun competition for all Cherokee Saddle Club members who like to spend time with their horses on the trails. We encourage all members to meet with other like-minded members and have fun riding together while enjoying the beautiful trails afforded to equestrians all around our area.

If participating in this fun competition, please read the following rules outlined below and download the Equilab Equestrian Tracker Application in either Apple or Android format. The Equilab Tracker offers both a free version and a subscription version; either can be used for the purpose of tracking rides for this competition. For those using the FREE version some information will need to be manually submitted to club administration in order to be tracked for this competition.

Rules:

1. Participants in this Trail Competition must be ACTIVE members of the Cherokee County Saddle Club.
2. Participants must be able to track their rides using the Equilab Equestrian Tracker Application available in both Apple/ IOS or Android formats. (This application offers a free version that can be used for this Tracking with some manual submissions of information required.)
 - a. With the FREE version rider will need to submit a screenshot of the tracking screen from the Equilab application showing the following information:
 - i. Rider Name
 - ii. Horse Name
 - iii. Date of Ride
 - iv. Map of Ride
 - v. Distance of Ride
 - vi. Speed of Ride
 - vii. Total Minutes Riding
 - viii. Elevation of Ride
 - b. With the Subscription version, the rider can join the Cherokee Saddle Club Stable and share the ride information electronically with club administration. No additional manual submissions would be required.
 - c. For members using the FREE version a screen-print is required in order to include the ride in competition tracking.
 - d. Participants may also submit a maximum of one photo taken on each trail ride. The photo must include a horse or rider or both, no photos of just scenery. You must identify all horses and riders in your photos. By submitting photos, you agree that they may be displayed by CCSC in its newsletter and webpage.
3. All submissions must be provided in the above formats no later than January 5, 2023 in order to be included for year-end awards.
4. Prizes will be awarded in the following categories:
 - a. Most miles covered
 - b. Most minutes riding.
 - c. Highest average speed of rides
 - d. Highest elevation ridden
 - e. Most miles traveled to rides
 - f. Best photo
